## Permit Fees slashed ; no increase in Licence fees

The FMSCI Council which met on 17<sup>th</sup> January 2019, unanimously decided that there shall be no increase in the Competition Licence Fees.

The Council also decided to reduce the Permit Fees for Status including and above Challenge, Cups, Series to encourage more organizers to run these type of events. The permit fees which used to be charged per class has now been changed to a flat permit fee upto 8 classes.
