

Bittersweet outing for Rajiv

Honda Racing India's Rajiv Sethu on Saturday became the first Indian to finish in top-7 in the AP 250 class qualifying race in the FIM Asia Road Racing Championship but met with a crash in the main race to end at 22nd, reports PTI from Buriram.

The morning qualifier saw Rajiv record the best ever finish by an Indian in top-7. Unfortunately, he crashed and despite minor damage to the handle-bar, he managed to finish the race.

Starting 20th on the grid, the other rider Senthil Kumar finished at 18th position.
