CHAPTER 3: COMMON TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

1. Reads as

"Chain Guards

If the primary transmission is exposed, it must be fitted with a guard as safety measure designed in such a manner that under no circumstances can the rider come in to accidental contact with the primary transmission part."

Changed to

Chain Guards

If the primary transmission/drive is exposed, it must be fitted with a guard as a safety measure designed in such a manner that under no circumstances can the rider come in to accidental contact with the primary transmission/drive part.

<u>Primary transmission refers to- Crankshaft to input of the gearbox</u> <u>Secondary transmission refers to-Output of gearbox to rear wheel</u>

A metal shield (MS) having a minimum thickness of 2.5 mm, should be fitted to cover the front sprocket (Gearbox drive sprocket) of the secondary drive as a safety measure and designed in such a manner that under no circumstances can the rider come in to accidental contact with the gear box drive sprocket and the chain around it.

2.Reads as

"For Circuit Racing

No guard shall be permitted over the secondary chain, except at the bottom of the secondary Chain where the chain comes in contact with the driven sprocket, must be fitted."

Addition

The metal shield mentioned under Chain Guards is also mandatory

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
