

Indian racing team gears up for Round 3 of ARRC

New Delhi: Honda Racing India's Rajiv Sethu and Senthil Kumar will be gunning for their best performance at the familiar Chang international circuit when the third round of the Asia

Road Racing Championship (ARRC) will get underway in Thailand from May 31. Leading the ARRC charge in Asia Production (AP250) class is the experienced Rajiv. After sweeping

double digit points for the first time in Australia, Rajiv is being viewed as a serious contender in the 2019 championship. Compared to his 27th position last year, Rajiv is already in top 12

with 18 points so far in AP 250 class. Backing Rajiv up will be Senthil. In his debut ARRC year, Senthil has already won two points and is all charged to push the throttle in Buriram. **TNN**
