

Not into investing in tracks in India, says Honda

Despite a dearth of racing tracks in India, Japanese auto giant Honda does not have plans of investing in the construction of a new one in India just yet, as it first wants to groom a “local hero” and in turn generate more awareness about motorsport in the cricket-mad country, a top official said. The Madras Motor Race Track in Chennai and the Buddh International Circuit in Greater Noida are the only two racing tracks recognised by Federation Internationale de Motocyclisme (FIM).

Among the other tracks, the one in Coimbatore is mainly used for domestic competitions while the others around the country are only good for carting, according to officials. IANS
