FMSCI COUNCIL'S REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2020-2021

48th ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING ADDRESS BY PRESIDENT Mr.Akbar Ebrahim

We have gone through very turbulent and unprecedented times in the last two years due to the COVID outbreak and have all collectively been pained by the loss and damage COVID has created to one and all.

The sport at large took a massive hit in the early part of 2020 as well as 2021. Nevertheless, the V-shaped recovery thanks to the determination and will of the motor sporting fraternity has created ripples of appreciation and respect from one and all across the globe following Indian motorsport.

I wish to thank the entire motor sporting fraternity for their unstinted support and cooperation extended to the FMSCI to help it tide over troubled times and come out stronger than ever before.

I would like to highlight below some of the important sporting events that took place in the years under review.

In addition to the above there have been numerous Cups, Challenges, Series and Open status events conducted in various disciplines.

In the year 2020, a total of 91 permits were issued. In the year 2021 till 27th October, a total of 119 permits were issued. This clearly highlights the resolve and commitment of all involved in the sport to stand together and ensure that this sport will always be a way of life.

New Introductions:

Post the introduction of India's first 4w Racing League in 2019, the FMSCI in association with Racing Promotions Pvt Ltd is proud to announce the introduction of the FIA Formula Regional Championship (F3 Cars) and the FIA F4 National Championship which is all set to kick off in February 2022 and will run along with the Indian Racing League which will also have the brand new Wolf sports cars in its kitty.

Most importantly, the FIA has sanctioned the allocation of FIA driver points for the FIA Formula Regional and the FIA F4 National Championship which is now one of the most important requirements for any driver intending to climb up the ladder to get a Super License which will then enable them to be eligible to drive in Formula 1.

The FMSCI is also proud to announce the new 2w Supercross Racing League in association with Aashan Sports which will commence in 2022. This will also be a first in the 2w segment.

The National Regularity Run Championship has commenced in 2021 after a long break which gives a tremendous boost to the grass root level of motor sport.

The National Autocross Championship is all set to commence in 2022 with a new promoter.

Training Seminars attended by our V&O:

The FIM Asia Virtual CCR Seminar was cleared by 7 of our officials and 6 officials for COC / Sporting Steward licence in the FIM Asia Virtual CMS Seminar and 2 of our officials as Sporting Steward in the same and 3 officials has cleared the FIM Touring Seminar. 3 Officials have cleared FIM CCR Seminar as COC / Sporting Steward.

Manufacturer's involvement in the Sport:

We have seen an unprecedented growth in the involvement of manufacturers in the sport from JK Tyres, MRF, Mahindra, Volkswagen, Tata, Maruti, Toyota, Yokohama, Honda, Suzuki, TVS, Yamaha, Rolon, KTM, Royal Enfield etc. Their investments into the sport have been substantial and their future plans look even more promising.



Mahindra have surely and truly stamped their name in International Motorsport with astounding results in the Formula E Championship as well as in the MRF FMSCI Indian National Rally Championship.

Volkswagen has continued to up the ante by bringing out the new VW Polo Cup Car. Indian drivers wanting to make a career in Touring cars and GT Cars Internationally now have the ideal platform to work on in the form of the VW Polo Cup. VW Motorsport also continues to work with the Indian Rally drivers with the VW Polo Rally Car.

The 2W segment has been no less in terms of growth in the involvement of manufacturers in the sport. It is also very satisfying to see manufacturers now competing against each other and supporting private teams in the National Championship. Honda, Suzuki, TVS and Yamaha have further consolidated their single make classes running along with the National 2W & 4W Racing Championships. This has allowed young riders to graduate into the National Racing Championships. It is also gratifying to note of the support given by Honda, Suzuki, TVS and Yamaha to their talented riders in International Championships.

Indians in International Events

Due to prevailing COVID 19 situation and travel restrictions, a total number of 20 NOCs have been issued for our Indians to take part in International events.

Women in Motorsport Commission

The Women In Motorsport Commission has gone from strength to strength. The interest and participation level of women in various grass root and national level championships has increased tremendously as well as the involvement in the V&O and Medical platforms. The WIM India is also actively participating in all the FIA and FIM Asia Zone seminars as well as being very well represented by the WIM Commission chairperson in the FIA WIM Commission.

In Closing

Despite several setbacks faced due to the pandemic, almost all disciplines have kick started their activities and are on course for a successful completion of the same before 31st March 2022.

I would like to place on record my sincere appreciation to our Vice President Mr Farooq Ahmed, my fellow Councillors, Chairman of all the Commissions and Committees, Regional Co-ordinators, FMSCI officials and volunteers, Member Clubs, Sponsors, Media, Manufacturers, Government of India, FIA, FIM and the CIK, Competitors, Parents, and all the motorsport enthusiasts. 




Year 2020
