2023 FMSCI Safety Requirements for 2-Stroke Karting

i) Existing

Body Protection

- As from 1 January 2022, the use of karting body protection complying with FIA Standard 8870-2018, and of the correct size in relation to the Driver's height or up to one size lower will be mandatory for all Drivers at FIA Karting Championship, Cup and Trophy events and all international karting events
- Rib Guard/Body protection Mandatory for Micro & Cadet classes
- Neck Restrain is mandatory for Micro & Cadet classes

i) Amendment

Body Protection

- With Effect from 13th November 2023, the use of karting body protection complying with FIA Standard 8870-2018 `(Technical list n° 87), and of the correct size in relation to the Driver's height or up to one size lower will be mandatory for all classes of FMSCI 2 stroke Karting Championship, Cup and Trophy events.
- Neck Restrain is mandatory for Micro & Cadet classes
